Against immensely strong competition from swimmers from across the country three Leatherhead Swimming Club swimmers came away with 4 medals. Stuart McCrea one of the senior swimmers at the club took the bronze medal in the men's open 100m backstroke, one of his specialist events and then to everyone's surprise he won the silver medal in the men's open 50m butterfly event with a personal best time of 27.44.

Grace Archer still recovering from a chest infection which affected her badly at the recent Welsh National Championships performed brilliantly to come 2nd in the girls 14/15yrs 200m butterfly with a personal best and National Qualifying time of 2.25.83. Grace's relay partner Charlotte Hobbs also took silver this time in the girls 14/15yrs 200m backstroke.

There were personal best times for other Leatherhead swimmers, Tom Matthews, Andrew Norman, Jack Beddoes, Liam Mellett, Alastair Davis, Callum Room, Laura-Anne Dymore-Brown, David Andrews, Helen Davis, Shahira Ishak, Allan Campbell and Sam Crowther. Coach Ron Philpot said, "I am pleased with these swims, we are in a period of heavy training at present and I would not expect particularly good times so to have so many PBs swum is an excellent result."
